

Mallorca Adventure Tour Travel Guide

Planning Your Arrival

Traveling to Mallorca is easy and convenient. You can get to the island by ferry or by plane from Spain, as well as several other European destinations. The Palma de Mallorca International Airport (Son Sant Joan) is located 8km east of the capital and is one of the busiest airports in Spain.

Whether you arrive the day of, or days before, the Adventure Tour begins, we'll begin picking up guests from your arrival locations or prior hotels at NOON on October 14th.

By Air (about 1 hour)

Fly to Palma de Mallorca, Son Sant Joan Airport (PMI) from many European cities arriving no later than 11am for pickup and transfer to our first hotel: Hotel Sa Bassa Rotja.

By Ferry (about 7 hours)

Ferries leave Barcelona at 9:30, 10:15 and 10:45PM, arriving at 4:30, 5:30, and 6:00AM respectively in Palma. Prices are currently displaying at \$70-\$78.

Arriving at these early AM hours, activities will be limited. You'll be in the heart of town, which comes to life at 8:00am. https://www.directferries.com/barcelona_palma_ferry.htm

Packing Recommendations

- o Padded cycling shorts
- o Chamois cream (to prevent chaffing)
- Cycling shoes (if you bring your own pedals)
- Sneakers (if you don't bring your own pedals)
- o Athletic socks
- o Arm/leg warmers
- Lightweight waterproof wind-resistant jacket or vest – bright color
- o Bike gloves
- o Bike saddle (if you prefer your own)
- o Bike pedals (if you prefer your own)
- Refillable water bottle

Off The Bike

- Walking shoes
- o Long and short sleeved shirts
- o Sweater/jacket for evenings
- o Casual dining wear
- o Swimsuit
